


Who We Are!

We are the Interfaith Homeless Emergency Lodging Program (I-HELP), operated by Outreach Unlimited, a nonprofit 501(c) (3). Tax ID #38-3934212.

I-HELP is run by a volunteer board of directors and a part-time staff, collaborating with over 60 Monterey-area congregations, faith communities, and service organizations to provide overnight accommodation, warm meals, and person-to-person support.

We also collaborate with other agencies such as the Coalition of Homeless Services Providers, Salvation Army, Gathering for Women, Veterans Transition Center, Interim, Central Coast Center for Independent Living, and the One Starfish Program. In addition, local hospitals refer outpatients to I-HELP who have nowhere to go when released.

How We Do It!

We accept client applications from unhoused people. Our overnight monitors provide our clients adjust to group living and accessing resources. We expect our clients to get along with others and follow directions.

Every effort is made to help each person with their long-term success. We help each participant to set unique goals for health care, work or income/benefits, and housing.

Our licensed commercial bus drivers operate our fleet of coaches which were donated by Monterey Salinas Transit. Many of our clients/staff graduate from our program to become our bus drivers.
